
# WALKER SCHOOL FRIDAY NEWSLETTER. For the week ending February 8, 2019

### NOTE FROM MRS. MORING, OUR GUIDANCE COUNSELOR:

The State of Maine has mandated training and education for all staff and students in public schools on Preventing and Responding to Child Sexual Abuse. - (1) Obtain package (baggie) containing (2) CLYNK bags from the Office.
- (2) Place your redeemable bottles and cans in green bag/s w/ affixed label provided.
- (3) Drop off filled bags at your nearest CLYNK center. (There is a "fill line" on the bag and the maximum weight is 20 pounds per bag.)


